How to Prepare & Send Your Sample

1.	Write your horse's name on a zip-lock bag and put 1 small ball of fresh manure into the bag (approx. 1 tablespoon is sufficient)		Office Use	e Only
2.	Squeeze out the air from the bag and seal it. Repeat for each horse.		Payment Date	
3.	Put all the individual sample bags into another zip-lock bag and seal it. Wrap them together in plastic wrap (a few layers) if you don't have a large zip-lock bag. This helps keep the odour locked inside as it permeates the plastic bags quite quickly.		Received Date	
4.	Place the bag and this form into a padded envelope (or wrap in bubble wrap and use a postage satchel) and post to: Hoofbeats FEC Service, 96 Ceylon Road, Belli Park QLD 4562. Please note: Exposure to ongoing heat will kill the eggs within a few days, so it's important to post/deliver the sample as soon as possible and to Express Post samples to ensure that your results are accurate.
